

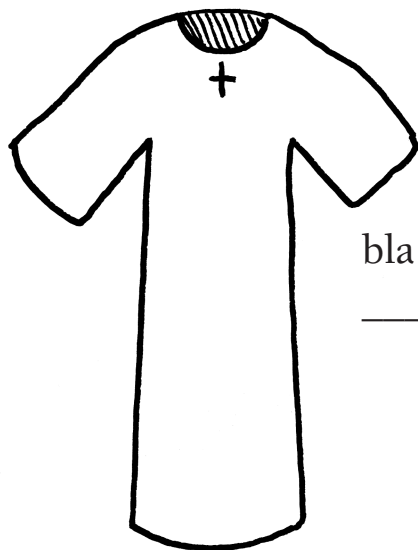
What the Priest Wears at Mass

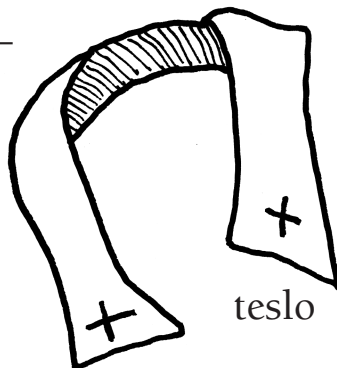
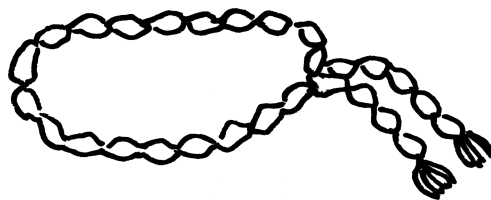

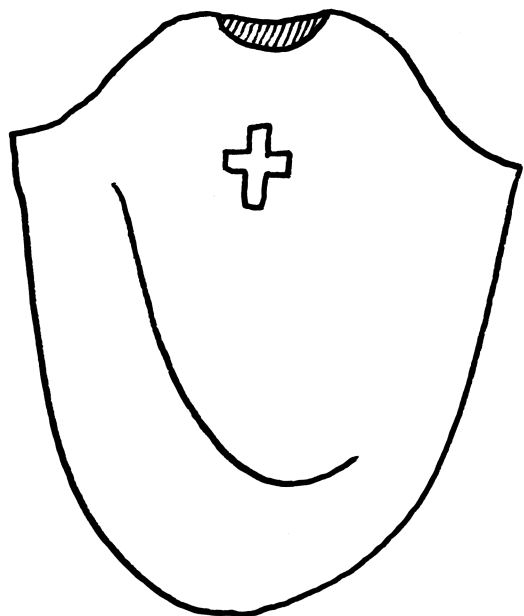

Father wears a different colored chasuble and stole at different times of the year. Each color has a special meaning:

Green is for Ordinary Time. Green stands for hope, growth and life.

White is for Easter and Christmas. It is also used at funerals. White stands for Jesus' resurrection and victory over sin.

Gold is for the most special days of the year—Easter Sunday, Christmas, and other very big feast days.

Purple is for Advent and Lent. This color shows that we are sorry for our sins.

Red stands for the Holy Spirit, the blood of Jesus, and the blood of the martyrs. It's used on Pentecost and feasts that have to do with the cross of Jesus and the martyrs who died for Jesus.
